What can a clinical pharmacist do for you?

- Medication Reviews: Maria and Mahlia complete thorough medication reviews to ensure your treatments are effective and safe.
- Health Checks: They can perform health checks such as taking your blood pressure and arranging other necessary tests, like blood tests.
- Long-Term Condition Support: If you have a long-term condition, they can discuss your medications with you to ensure they are working as intended.
- Medication Adjustments: If your medication is causing adverse effects, they can help by adjusting the dosage or changing the medication.
- Multiple Medications: If you take multiple medications, they will ensure they are all working well together.
- Post-Hospital Care: If your medications were changed during a hospital stay, Maria and Mahlia can explain these changes and ensure they are beneficial for you.

What Does a Pharmacy Technician Do?

- Repeat Medication Requests: Helena processes repeat medication requests and converts acute requests to repeat prescriptions.
- Drug Monitoring and Reconciliation: She ensures adherence to drug monitoring protocols and reconciles medications after hospital stays.
- Community Pharmacy Liaison: Helena coordinates with local pharmacies to source alternative items during stock shortages.
- Support for GPs and Pharmacists: She organises necessary monitoring tests and manages shared care protocols between the practice and hospitals.
- **Medication Audits:** Helena assists in the development and review of medication audits.
- Medication Queries: She is a point of contact for patients and colleagues regarding medication queries and helps resolve prescribing issues.

Important Prescribing Updates

- Diazepam for Fear of Flying: Eaglescliffe Medical Practice will no longer prescribe diazepam for fear of flying. Patients are encouraged to explore other non-pharmacological options for managing flight anxiety.
- Norethisterone for Period Delay: Norethisterone, commonly requested for delaying periods during holidays, is available via your local dispensing pharmacy following a consultation and should not be requested via prescription.
- Hay fever Management: For hay fever advice and products,
 please visit your community pharmacy. Please note that requests
 for prescription-strength fexofenadine are only indicated for
 urticaria which is a raised, itchy rash, and not typical hay fever
 symptoms.
